QCP Was founded by parents whose children had cerebral palsy and other developmental disabilities so that their children could receive the help they so desperately needed. QCP has grown to become a major provider of services for people with developmental disabilities in Queens County and the New York Metropolitan area. The agency currently provides a comprehensive array of services to more than twelve hundred people.
